## 13.2 Graduation or completion targets for students from the bottom 20% household income group (domestic)

In the past, students from vulnerable groups, low-income families, and underprivileged backgrounds achieved a 100% graduation rate. This success is attributed to their strong determination to complete their studies and pursue a career, as well as the continuous support they receive through scholarships and various forms of assistance throughout their time at the university.

In 2024, overlapping the academic years 2023 and 2024, there were 1,711 students from vulnerable families who graduated from Thaksin University
